QUALIFICATIONS

The A/V Design Technician I must possess excellent written and verbal communication skills to effectively interact with sales, technical, and accounting staff. The AVDT I must be capable of creating system drawings and documenting information on a computer with efficiency, accuracy, and attention to detail. Comfortable working knowledge of Microsoft applications and experience with database entry are necessary to perform the duties of this position.

The A/V Design Technician I needs to be able to comfortably interact with customers, product suppliers, and other business associates on the phone and in person.
